















4) Assembly: Leg Assembly



- Locate the caster and caster pin.
- Using a hammer, carefully knock the caster pin into the caster until it is completely seated.



- Locate one of the leg columns.
- Firmly press the caster pin into the bottom of the leg column.
- Caster should seat completely in leg and then swivel freely.



- Single Leg assembly shown.
- Repeat these steps for all 4 of the leg columns.

4) Assembly: Leg Assembly (continued)



- Locate the leg connection key.
- Insert the key into the slot of the single leg.



- Insert the second leg component onto the other side of the key.
 Slide the second leg up until the tops of the legs
- NOTE: leg components will continue to slide up and down until attached to frame.



- Verify that the key is seated securely in the leg columns by gently pulling the legs apart.
- If there is a gap between the legs, shift the legs vertically until the key is seated properly.
- Complete the above steps for both sets of legs.

4) Assembly: Leg Attachment



- Locate the pre-assembled frame sub-assembly
- Locate the M8 x 70mm Flat head bolts included in the hardware pack.

- While holding the leg columns together, line up the mounting holes in the legs with the clearance holes in the frame sub assembly.
- Slide the leg columns onto the beam.
- Using the M8 x 70mm bolts, connect the legs to the frame.
- Again, verify that the leg columns are firmly secured together and do not come apart.



- Repeat the above steps for the other set of legs.
- Locate the included black end caps.
- Push in the end caps into the open ends of the beam.

4) Assembly: Frame Placement and Attachment



- Lay the top face down on a non-marring surface.
- Place the frame on the top with the black flip mechanisms spaced evenly from the sides of the table.
- Line up the holes in the flip mechanisms with the pre-drilled holes in the work surface.
- Attach the frame to the top with the included wood screws.
- Insert the included Cap Covers into the holes in the flip mechanisms to cover the screws.
